Welcome to Heritage Community Kids (CK)—the Children’s Ministry at Heritage Community Church (HCC). We are so excited to “introduce” our ministry to you. At HCC, we value children and families. ## Where Do We Go?

There are 3 nursery facilities on Nursery Lane, a Parents' Room, and a Nursing Mother's area. During your visit to Nursery Lane, a Room Mother and a team of caregivers will greet you and your child when you arrive. You will complete the sign-in information at the nursery door and will be provided with an ID tag that corresponds to your child's number of the day.

This tag is required at pick-up time. If we need you before dismissal, your number will appear on the main sanctuary display screen.

## What Will My Child Do at Church?

During your child's visit to Preschool Path, he/she will experience hands-on activities, learning stations, music, praise and worship, classroom teaching, Bible lessons, puppet shows, arts and crafts, special guests and so much more.

## Which Classroom Will My Child Be In?

Children are assigned to the same Pre-K class for the entire year (which runs September to September). Whatever age your child is in August 31, determines which classroom he/she will be assigned to for the entire CK year. (i.e. if your son is 3 years old on August 31, he will be assigned to the GREEN, 3 year old room, for the entire year.) He will not move to a new class when he has a birthday. *(The only children who move with their birthdays are toddlers who move to Pre-K when they turn 3 years old.)*
